Indicate the ways in which you wish to participate in this event:

Artist Vendor – 10' x 10' booth spaces, \$15 per space. Artwork must have a landscape/nature /wildlife focus. Vendors must be setup by 10 am and remain setup until 6 pm. No early tear-downs will be permitted. Vendors are responsible for collection and reporting of state sales tax and providing their own canopy, tables, chairs, displays, etc.

Plein Air Demonstrator – Artist may select a location along the Lion's Club River Walk or on Lighthouse Island to demonstrate their approach to working en plein air. Demonstrating artists will receive a \$100 stipend for the day and must actively demonstrate throughout the day (10 am – 6 pm, with breaks.) Demonstrating artists may also register as a Workshop Instructor, taking a break from their demonstration to teach their scheduled workshop. Artist must sign a signed W-9 form to receive their stipend. Funding is available for a limited number of demonstrating artists. Registrations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis.

Mini Workshop Instructor – Artists are invited to teach a 1-hour landscape/nature/wildlife art workshop in their chosen medium. Instruction space (tent, tables, and chairs) will be provided by FAAC. Equipment and materials for the workshop to be supplied by the artist instructor, with a reimbursement of up to \$2.50 per student (maximum of \$50) for materials. Artist must sign a W9 form to receive their stipend. Funding is available for a limited number of workshop instructors. Registrations will be accepted on a first come/first served basis and are subject to event committee approval to ensure variety in the workshops offered. A representative of FAAC will contact the artist to schedule their workshop.

Setup begins at 8 am. All vendors and demonstrators must be setup by 10 am and remain setup until 6 pm. No early tear-downs will be permitted. This is a rain or shine event. No refunds will be made for vendor booth fees. Demonstrating artists will receive their stipend at the end of the event and only if they remain for the entire day. Instructing artists will be paid their stipend at the end of their scheduled class time, and reimbursed for materials based on the actual number of students participating.

FAAC reserves the right to take photos and video of artists and their work for web and print promotion of the *Art on the Allegheny* event and the FAAC.

FAAC will promote all participating artists via the FAAC website, Facebook page, newspaper articles, and any other promotion conducted after receipt of the artist's registration and after the event.
